LITURGY: CHANGES IN TEXTS

I went to a workshop for priests on the new texts for Mass. The changes will probably not take effect until November 27, 2011 or later (Don't quote me). Pope John Paul II traveled the globe, bringing the presence of the Pope to many places and celebrating Mass in many languages. He noticed that the languages did not always agree with each other or with the Latin originals, for in every translation, something of the original meaning necessarily changes. In relation to each other, the various modern languages seemed to have had different Latin originals. For this reason, he saw the need of returning to the original texts and translate them more closely to the Latin, and therefore, to each other.

This does not mean that we have bad translations now. It does mean that we did not correlate our English translations with the translations of other languages. It also means that as we have reflected on the texts we have used for forty years, we have come to see some need for translating them again.


