FATHER DAVID VINCENT'S COLUMN

I wanted to thank all the teenagers for dressing up for my birthday (It now takes four average high school seniors to equal my age), but then somebody whispered to me that they had stopped for Mass on the Way to the Prom. I do appreciate the fact that the Prom-goers dress up and celebrate Mass before they go. Thanks, teenagers, for your witness of faith.

Leave it to the Vincent girls to celebrate well. My sisters got together with me for a tour of the old home-sites, where Mom and Dad first lived when they came to Dayton. The original house, where my older brother first saw the light of day, has turned into a parking lot. The second house, where I came to birth, long ago gave way to new house. We knocked on its door, introduced ourselves and asked permission to take a picture of the address. The owner said that the foundation of the original house remained and that we could take pictures of it. It felt weird to me to stand in the very place Mom gave birth to me years ago.

LITURGY: CHANGES IN TEXTS

Does "And also with you" mistranslate your response to the priest's greeting, "The Lord be with you"? Yes, but No. Our original translation put the reference to the Spirit in the first part of the dialogue, "The Spirit of the Lord be with you." This allowed the response "And also with you". Somewhere in the process, however, the reference to the Spirit dropped out of the greeting and inadvertently remained out of the response. Thus came to birth the dialogue, "The Lord be with you. And also with you" that we have today.

I picked up a deeper appreciation for the current texts of the Mass and a deeper appreciation of the coming changes at a workshop for priests on the new texts for Mass two weeks ago.

The Worship Commission will get a close look at the coming changes this week at a special meeting and then invite you to their regular meeting the following Wednesday at 7:00 in the basement of St Denis Church. The Commission wants to share with you and all the parishioners some insights on the Mass and the new translations.
