FATHER DAVID VINCENT'S COLUMN

We have had at least six funerals this Easter season. I asked God why. I get the distinct impression that he wants me to see all funerals in the light of his Son's resurrection. Death does not end relationships, but it does change them.

LITURGY: LANGUAGE

In what language did Rome first celebrate the Eucharist? Does Greek surprise you? The first Christians in Rome used Greek as their language. Later, when the Christians spoke Latin, the Church changed to Latin.

The sixteenth century saw a movement towards the vernacular, but the Protestant Reformation put an end to it. This use of language helped people distinguish the Catholics from the Protestants. In the twentieth, the vernacular movement revived. By this time, the Church had enough trust that her members could tell the difference between Catholic and Protestant worship that the Second Vatican Council authorized the use of modern languages in the liturgy. Today, God has blessed us with the use of our native languages in the liturgy.


