Congratulations to the senior classes of Ansonia and Versailles. We have enjoyed your presence as you grew up in your families among us. Now we look forward to having you among us as young adults. Keep close to the Catholic Church.

We hope that, if you marry, you do it in the Church. For a sacramental marriage and a valid marriage, you should have a Catholic marriage, one celebrated before a priest, deacon or someone delegated for the occasion by the archbishop. A Catholic marriage provides sacramental help to fulfill the duties and joys of marriage. Keep close to the Catholic Church.

**LITURGY: ASCENSION**

We celebrate the Solemnity of the Ascension this weekend. Several years ago, our bishops received permission to move the celebration from Thursday to Sunday. The pope and our bishops concurred that the feast was of such great importance that it deserved moving it to a Sunday. In my experience, people had a hard time remembering the Ascension when it came on Thursday. Moving the feast to Sunday enables us all to celebrate it.

Some people confuse the feast of the Ascension of the Lord with the feast of the Assumption of Mary. The Ascension refers to Christ's entrance into glory after the resurrection appearances to the disciples. The Assumption refers to Mary's entrance into glory at the end of her life on earth. Ascending denotes the active movement of going up (Jesus went up); assumption refers to a passive movement (Mary did not get to heaven on her own; the Lord Jesus took her).
