#### FATHER DAVID VINCENT'S COLUMN

Parents have children to get rid of them. They receive them in trust as infants and have less than eighteen years to prepare them for responsible Christian adulthood. Then they release them into God's care as adults.

May your children grow up well, leave home well, accomplish the work God has for them and return to you many times over the blessings you have given them. May they outdo you in holiness and add splendor to the family name and the Church. May they, like good students, add to the knowledge of their parent-teachers.

#### LITURGY: MYSTAGOGIA

Mystagogy means catechizing from the mystery celebrated. This definition tells you nothing unless you know what catechesis means. It explains and teaches. Mystagogy starts from what we can see and moves towards what we do not see.

We have a period of mystagogy at Mass. It follows the Communion and it happens in silence. It takes place between the end of distributing communion and the Prayer after Communion. During this time, we do not thank God, which we have done during the Eucharistic Prayer, nor do we meditate, which we have done in the pause between the readings at Mass. We do, however, praise God for the mysteries we have celebrated and we usually do this silently.

As we realize what has happened to us, what we have experienced, what the Lord has done for us in the Eucharist, we praise God. This mystagogy leads us to praise.


