FATHER DAVID VINCENT'S COLUMN

Now that graduation has come, summer vacation can come. As you move about in the summer, remember that we all need to take part in the Eucharist every Sunday. The Church law that says this merely puts in writing what our faith in God demands of us. In other words, even without Church law, we would have to celebrate the Paschal Mystery at Mass every Sunday.

We Christians need the Eucharist more than we need a daily shower. The very nature of our life in Christ demands this. Without the Sunday Eucharist, we cannot grow in our relationship with Christ and with one another. Cutting ourselves out of the Eucharist cuts us off from Christ, his Church and his people.

LITURGY: EUCHARIST

In the Eucharist, we ought to experience deep within a yearning for unity and togetherness. We have received the sacrament of unity, where the signs used to proclaim the mystery of faith come from many grains of wheat and many bunches of grapes, both put under intense pressure and made into bread and wine. From all this many, we have but one unity, one bread, one cup, one and only one body and blood of the Lord Jesus.

When we come together for meals, we usually eat and drink. We understand vegetarians, but we do not understand those who drink no beverage with their meals, especially those who say, "The meat, potatoes and vegetables all have water in them; I do not need more." While this has some truth in it, we do need to eat and drink at our meals.

The same holds for Communion, we ought to eat and drink even though we can receive the whole Christ under each form. Both eating and drinking give us a fuller sign of the Eucharistic banquet.
