FATHER DAVID VINCENT'S COLUMN

Oh boy! I get to go to a conference this week on stewardship. Maybe I should not sound so enthusiastic, even with tongue in cheek. I shall go for several reasons, because the Archbishops want us priests to go, because I need to learn how to preach stewardship to you and I need to learn more about stewardship for myself.

Stewardship proclaims that what I have I do not own, but have it from God on loan. I have to return to God what God owns. Part of stewardship involves tithing, literally a tenth, giving a percentage of income off the top back to God in a spirit of gratitude. The rest of stewardship consists in considering my body, my talents and hobbies as gifts from God who owns me, lock, stock and barrel and who has redeemed me. To him I owe every heartbeat and every breath. This I expect to learn more about in the conference on stewardship. In the fall we start a stewardship program in the parish.

LITURGY: HOW WE PRAY

Once upon a time, the pastor would assemble all the school children in the front of church, close to the altar and preach to them the catechism. As younger children grew up, the older ones moved towards the back and eventually in their older age took the back rows of pews. Now, in our time, things have changed so that we want, need and strongly desire to have the older adults in the front of church to show us the proper way of participating fully, actively and consciously in the liturgy. We need the adults to lead the way in singing, responding to the priest, listening and praising God. Without the example of the older adults, we fail to teach our younger members. In today's church, the back should fill last and the front fill first.
