# FATHER DAVID VINCENT'S COLUMN

I did go to the conference on stewardship this week, but I cannot tell you anything about it because I wrote this before I went. Stewardship, however, flows from our liturgical encounter with God through Christ. If we have celebrated the liturgy well, priest and people, then we shall experience a new attitude towards creation and Creator. We shall come to see creation as coming from the Creator to us on loan. God owns us and gives us everything we need to return the loan with interest. In doing so, we find the source of our happiness in God. We come in thanksgiving to the Eucharist and bring what God has given us as we praise God.

# LITURGY: HOW WE PRAY

Full, conscious and active participation in the liturgy marks the goal of the Church and the reason for the reform of the Mass after the Second Vatican Council. In the liturgy, we have the immensely intimate challenge of glorifying God as Jesus Christ has taught us. While we do not engage in liturgy to get something out of it for ourselves, nonetheless, we do receive much benefit and grace. We gather to praise and magnify the Lord. We come at God's invitation and he gives us more than w can give back. Full, conscious and active participation should jolt us out of our complacent places in church and put us on fire with love of God and one another.

The idea of "full, conscious and active participation" did not originate with the council. All the Popes of the twentieth century promoted this participation. The words I wrote last week, came from a desire to promote better this participation in the parish.


# WORKSHOPS ON THE LITURGY
