LITURGY: THE TIMEKEEPER

The Liturgy presents some interesting challenges. Regarding silence, for instance, we have very specific guidelines. We ought to observe silence after the first reading, after the second reading and after the homily so that we can digest the word of God.

I try to do this, but several times, I have come to myself and wondered if I had fallen asleep. I have concluded that the liturgy needs a timekeeper, someone to keep us on track. This person has to reflect, but also remain aware of the congregation and the liturgical action so as not to prolong too much the silence. By office, the task falls to the presiding priest. The silence shall challenge me to listen, absorb and keep the proper momentum in the liturgy.
