FATHER DAVE'S COLUMN

Two weeks ago, I asked if seminarians and priests had horns. I went to the cookout for seminarians and priests last Sunday. I did not see any horns, but I did eat at a table with a seminarian named Tom who had just graduated from the Citadel Military Academy. He said that he had turned down a \$47,000 job offer to go into the seminary. I suppose that some thought he had rocks in his head, but he seemed perfectly sane to me. He explained that no amount of money could buy him happiness if he did not heed God's call to him. All those present seemed well adjusted and happy people.

People go to seminaries to discern their vocations, to discover what plans God has for them. People date people to discern their vocations, whom to marry if God calls them to marry. Those who rush into permanent commitments without the discernment, risk their happiness and fulfillment.

LITURGY: ASSUMPTION

Did Mary die? Even though people die and Jesus himself died, a strong and Catholic thread in theology maintains that Mary did not die. It says that at the end of her life, God took her body and soul into heaven. When Pope Pius XII defined the doctrine of the Assumption of Mary as a dogma of the Church, the adroitly put the Assumption of Mary at the end of her life and did not say anything about her death. The dogma says that God could have allowed Mary to triumph over death in going from this life to heaven. Someday we hope to join her in the glory of her Son, the Lord Jesus Christ.
