FATHER DAVE'S COLUMN: NEVER-FAIL NOVENAS

If the information says, "This noven never fails" and if you "must leave" a number of copies in church on each day in succession, then you have an invitation to superstition, a form of idolatry. Superstition, in effect, gives efficacy to external things and not to interior dispositions. See the *Catechism of the Catholic Church*, paragraphs 2110-2111 and 2138.

Periodically, however, I find such notices in church. I wonder if those promoting such novenas have reached the end of patience and hope so as to have recourse to something that "will never fail". I wonder if, perhaps, the people promoting this do not understand the superstitious nature of it. The daily celebration of the Eucharist brings a greater efficacy on us.

Our prayers cannot force God's hand. Our prayers can help us understand God's hand and help us accept and celebrate his will for us.
