FATHER DAVE'S COLUMN:

I spoke last about an ordination to the priesthood I took part in while in Mexico. The coming Saturday, we call can take part in an ordination to the diaconate. Bishop Joseph Charron, C.P.P.S., a retired bishop from Des Moines, Iowa, will ordain Joe Grilliot, of Holy Family Parish to the order of the diaconate at 10:30 at the St Charles Center on Route 127. We can take great delight in this because ordinations attest to the vitality of our parishes and our families.

God has deigned to bless Joe's family and parish with an ordained minister. God plants seeds, but we must respond to God's call. How does God call each of us? Some he has called to marriage, others to the single life; some to the ordained ministry, some to service in the Church through celibacy or marriage. Within these vocations, God calls us everyday to fidelity to his designs and purposes for us.

LITURGY:

"Lord, send forth upon him [Joseph Grilliot] the Holy Spirit, that he may be strengthened by the gift of your sevenfold grace to carry out faithfully the work of the ministry [=diaconate] Rite of Ordination of Deacons, 21)". With these words and the laying on of hands, the bishop will ordain Joe Grilliot to the order of deacons.

Before this, the bishop inquires about the soundness of Joe's character and asks the people to consent to the ordination. Joe must also promise obedience to his legitimate superiors and their successors in office.

Ordination to the diaconate makes a person a cleric and readies Joe for ordination to the priesthood in September. Joe will function as deacon at the 9:30 Mass next Sunday.
