# FATHER DAVE'S COLUMN:

The Holy Spirit has marked a member of our parish with the spirit of service in the Church. We congratulate Joe Grilliot, not because he has done something wonderful, but because God has done wonderful things to him and to us in anointing him for service in the Church as a deacon. We congratulate John and Louise, his parents, and Carrie, Susan and Lisa, his sisters, for the blessings they have received and will receive in Joe's ordained ministry.

The diaconate [dee-AK-u-nut], the office of deacon, makes up the bottom rung of the sacrament of holy orders. The order of deacon stands by itself, in the sense that we can have permanent deacons, deacons who will not received ordination to the priesthood. It can also serve as a prelude to the ordained priesthood in the sense that we usually ordain men to the order of deacon before we ordain them to the priesthood.

# LITURGY:

The bishop alone imposes hands on the person ordained deacon. The bishop and priests present impose hands on the person ordained a priest. The deacon has a special relationship to the bishop; the fraternity of priests welcomes the newly ordained priest into the fraternity.

The deacon serves the Church during liturgy by assisting the presiding priest. He proclaims the gospel as its ordinary minister. He serves at the altar during the Eucharistic Prayer. He presents the chalice at communion as its ordinary minister. He wears the stole and dalmatic as a sign of his order. He moderates the General Intercessions as the minister of service.

He can baptism, solemnize weddings and preside at funerals as the ordinary minister of these sacred rites. He may preach during liturgical ceremonies as an ordinary minister of the word.


