We call forth Jessica Groff and Jenny Neiberg this week for the first of three Scrutinies. In the Scrutinies, God uncovers for us our weakness and sinfulness. He also uncovers our goodness. He strengthens us in our weakness and encourages us in our strengths. God does this for the Elect, those chosen for baptism, but he also does this for all of us. The story of the woman at the well calls us to seek Christ, the Water of Life, and to refuse all other drinking. The fact that those seeking baptism at the Easter Vigil confront the evil and weakness of their lives ought to challenge us to do the same with our lives. 
