FATHER DAVE'S COLUMN

Teenagers, have a good time at the prom this weekend. I appreciate the fact that school postponed the prom to avoid a conflict with Holy Saturday and the Easter Vigil. I also appreciate those of you who asked the school to move the date.

LITURGY: EASTER

We celebrate Easter as the Feast of Weeks. We have just finished the Sunday Week and have started the Monday Week. After the seventh week, the Saturday Week, we shall return to the upper room for fiftieth day, the day of Pentecost. Last Sunday and Pentecost Sunday celebrate the same gift from God, the glorification of the Lord Jesus Christ through his resurrection and the giving of the Holy Spirit.

Throughout the Easter season, we shall use the sprinkling rite instead of the penitential act. The sprinkling rite calls us back to our baptism.

Every time we celebrate the mysteries of the Lord in the Eucharist, we implicitly renew our baptismal promises and reaffirm our allegiance to Christ in his holy, Catholic Church. We do this at every Mass, not just when we receive a sacrament like confirmation.
