FATHER DAVE'S COLUMN

The 31 Club, what about it? The club seeks to provide a reminder that we should all pray for vocations. The archbishop's prayer that we use on weekends before Mass has us praying for all vocations. He lists marriage, the single life, priests and religious. While many think of fewer priests when they think of shortage of vocations, perhaps we have a bigger shortage in the vocation of marriage. Priests do not come from abstract families, but from concrete Christian families. If we do not have good Catholic families, we have fewer people in the pool for the ordained priesthood. If you want to promote vocations, sign up at the back of church for the 31 Club. Pick a calendar day when you will pray in a special way for vocations.

LITURGY: UNIVERSAL

Today we welcome back two good friends. We welcome Father Jaime Rojas who came here with Bishop Carmona last year. He wants to take up a collection for his poor diocese in southwestern Mexico and help us establish a twinning relationship in his diocese. He will spend a week in this northern part of the archdiocese, visiting Hispanic migrants and those working with them. Our patronage shows that our faith embraces the whole of the Church, not just the portion in which we live.

We also welcome back the Bethlehem Woodcarvers. This sale helps the Catholic people of Bethlehem survive the loss of tourism on which their economy has depended for many years. Our patronage helps them and shows our connectedness with the Christians in Palestine.

On Thursday, we also celebrate the ordination of Father Joseph Binzer as auxiliary bishop of Cincinnati. We have tickets available on a first-come, first-served basis.

All three events point out the universality of our Catholic faith, reaching beyond our parish.
