**FATHER DAVE'S COLUMN**

Let me introduce to you Faustino Pérez-Manglano. He died at the age of 16 and a half in 1963, a long time ago. His father once spanked him for disobeying and lying. He had trouble getting along with his sisters. He liked football (alias soccer) and had a favorite team. He died of Hodgkin's disease, but left a diary of everyday things. Pope Benedict XVI declared his virtues heroic this past January and gave him the title of Venerable.

"Where can I find out more about this young person?" I thought you'd never ask. I left some copies of his writings and life on the stand in the Penance Room. Feel free to stop in anytime and take one. If you plan on going to Madrid for World Youth Day, you may want to read about this remarkable youth who he lived in Valencia, Spain.

**LITURGY: UNIVERSAL**

Today's feast of Pentecost brings us back to the upper room of Easter and brings the Easter season to a close. We have celebrated fifty days, a mystical period of mystagogy and a time of enjoying in special way the presence of the risen Lord. Today's feast, like the final blessing of Mass, sends us out on mission, commissions us for the mission of bringing Christ into the world by our actions and lives.

Next Sunday, we celebrate the feast of the Most Blessed Trinity. This feast reminds us that the work of our redemption, accomplished by the life, death and resurrection of the Lord Jesus, involved equally the work and cooperation of the Father and the Son.

The Sunday after next, we shall celebrate the feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. We really celebrated this on Holy Thursday, but we set a day apart after Easter when we can focus more on this tremendous gift of Christ to us, his presence in the Church through our baptism and through the Eucharist.
