FATHER DAVE'S COLUMN

Several people have told me that somebody had locked the door into church off the parking lot. We used to have an allen wrench on a nearby window sill, but it disappeared and, shortly afterwards, the door has mysteriously locked itself on at least two occasions. We have kept the church unlocked over the years, but now someone seems to lock it. I find this very inconvenient and would like to have the key back.

LITURGY: THE BOOK OF WISDOM

Next Sunday's first reading comes from the book of Wisdom (12:13, 16-18). Protestants do not consider this book inspired. It comes to us only in a Greek text. The Jewish population of Alexandria in Egypt probably composed the work sometime after the official Septuagint Greek translation of the Hebrew scriptures. This would put its composition around the year 50 B.C. and make it the last of the Old Testament books. All of these factors helped the Protestants reject the inspiration of the book. God, however, can inspire his word in any language in any time and in any place. The Church accepts this book as part of the Bible.

The book has two main parts, a praise of Wisdom and a narrative of God's faithfulness to his people in the Exodus. The passage for next Sunday will talk about God's clemency and mercy. It will serve as a reflection on the agricultural themes in the gospel (Matthew 13:24-43).
