## **FATHER DAVE'S COLUMN**

"Thou shalt not hext in church." I recently found out that we have people who dare hext in church. Hext means to send text messages during the homily. I did some investigation and found the facts. Some people do hext at Mass. One did it to pass on a good idea he heard in the homily of the day. Another liked the homily so much that he went to betterhomiliesforbettercatholics.com to find a good one. Thou shalt not hext.

I know the EMS need their phones when on call. All active phones, however, all phones turned on may interfere with the transmission of the wireless signals we use in out PA systems. Use of cell phones during the recent production of *The Secret Garden* caused some distortion to the sound.

As a courtesy, remind the pastor not to have his phone on during Mass and at the same time, make sure that you have turned yours off.

#### LITURGY: THE BOOKS OF KINGS

You may have two first Books of Kings. At one time, we included the two books of Samuel together with the books of Kings and counted four books of Kings. We find this in the Douay-Rheims translation. We now recognize the difference between the books of Samuel and the books of Kings and refer to them as Samuel and Kings. What older translations called the III and IV Books of Kings, we now call 1 and 2 Kings. The books of Samuel deal with the prophet Samuel and the rise of David. The books of Kings cover Solomon and the other kings of the kingdoms of Judah and Israel.

The passage used next weekend from the first book of Kings reflects the gospel's concern for wisdom and the choice of the good. The young king Solomon asks for the wisdom in order to lead the people of God rather than for long life and wealth. The Bible extols the wisdom of Solomon. It assigns the proverbs and maxims of the people of Israel to the wise Solomon. This wisdom established Solomon as one of the wisest persons of earth. It helped bring the Israelites great respect among the nations of the world (Cf. Deuteronomy 4:8).

For the Hebrews, wisdom meant the practical knowledge of how to do something. Wise persons still know how to live their lives correctly. We call the wisest among us saints.
