## **FATHER DAVE'S COLUMN**

Soon, thirteen of our youth and their pastor will set off on pilgrimage to Spain for World Youth Day. Our pilgrimage will take us to Compostela Spain, where the legend has it that the body of Santiago, or St James the Apostle, lies buried. It will take us into Portugal to Fatima. It will finally take us to Madrid to rendezvous with Pope Benedict, who has asked three young members of our group to join him near the front of the stage for the vigil service August 20. Pray for us pilgrims.

#### LITURGY: ISAIAH

We met Isaiah July 10. We met the second of three Isaiahs then. You have a right to question this statement. Scholars divide the book of Isaiah into three sections, each addressed to a specific group of Israelites living over several centuries. In the first thirty-nine chapters, the prophet speaks to the Israelites during the time of the kings. In the second part, the book addresses Israelites in exile. A third section addresses Israelites after the exile. The history registered in the book strongly supports several authors.

The passage for next Sunday comes from the same chapter we used July 10. The chapter concludes the second section of Isaiah, the Book of Comfort or Consolation.

The Lord, who allowed his people to go into exile, calls them forth from exile to eat and drink, to feast sumptuously at the Lord's Table, free of cost. God, speaking through the prophet, has found his people in a deserted place and multiplied food and drink for them. See also Matthew 14:13-21.


