FATHER DAVE'S COLUMN

Sometimes I feel old. Sometimes I feel the need for help. I started looking around for someone with a good background in theology, religion and pastoral experience several months ago. I think I have found such a person now. Jane Pierron, who has served the archdiocese well for twenty-four years in the Office of Evangelization and Catechesis, will leave the archdiocesan office at the end of this month. I think she would make a very good part-time assistant to me. She already has directed our RCIA program as a volunteer for six years. She knows the Church and has had much experience in working with the archdiocesan leaders. I do not want this experience to go to waste and I can use her well in the work of the parish.

LITURGY: ISAIAH AND ST DENIS

The prophet Isaiah celebrates the enthronement of God as King. God celebrates his enthronement by preparing a banquet for all peoples and by destroying death forever. In the gospel, the King will host a banquet at the royal wedding of his son. We shall use the readings from the Sunday at Holy Family, but we must use the readings for St Denis at St Denis since his feast day supersedes the Sunday readings.

On feasts, the three readings usually mesh together to teach us something of the mystery or saint celebrated. St Denis Parish will use different readings. See the first column.

NEW ENGLISH TRANSLATION

Today, we start learning the new music for the new English translation. The red books in the pew contain the music. We shall learn first the music in the official book, a chanted version with simple but deep melodies. Later we shall learn more complex forms of the same texts. We shall rehearse in the fifteen minutes before Mass starts.
