LENT: A SEASON ABOUT BAPTISM

Lent has baptism as a primary emphasis. The Church of Rome considers the Apostles' Creed as the baptismal creed. The new translation of the Mass allows the use of the Apostles Creed to replace the Nicene Creed any time. During Lent and Easter, we shall use the Apostles Creed at Mass. This will start today. LITURGY: GENESIS

The Gospels for the second Sundays of Lent all feature the transfiguration of the Lord. The first reading sheds some light on the mystery of the transfiguration. In all three cycles of readings, the Church turns to the story of Abraham for insight. In Cycle A, the Lord promised to make Abraham a great nation. In Cycle C, the Lord appeared in a deep terrifying darkness and made a covenant with Abraham. In Cycle B for this year, the Lord stayed Abraham's hand from sacrificing his beloved Isaac.

God saved his only begotten and beloved Son Jesus from death and announced him as Lord and Savior. Does Abraham remind us more of the Father or the Son? Does Isaac remind us more of the Son, the father or the Church?



Notes:

- 1. If we have funerals, the 8:00 morning Mass on weekdays will yield to the funeral.
- 2. We hope to have at least six additional priests for the sacrament of penance at this service.
- 3. The Mass of Chrism: each year, on the Tuesday of Holy Week, the Archbishop blesses the oil we use in the sacraments. Many priests go and concelebrate with the Archbishop and renew their commitment to priestly service and life. We invite all the parishioners to go with us. We leave from the parking lot of St Denis at 3:15. We plan to eat supper in Cincinnati before the Mass. By leaving early, we hope to avoid rush hour traffic.
- 4. We may not have funeral Masses on Holy Thursday, Good Friday, or Holy Saturday. We may bury people, but we may not celebrate the funeral during Mass.
- 5. At the recommendation of the Worship Commission and the Pastoral Council, I have decided to have only one Mass on Holy Thursday and one Service (not Mass) on Good Friday. While I like the idea of celebrating the Triduum in each parish, we can accommodate the total attendance with just one service. We have to celebrate the Good Friday Service where we have the Holy Thursday Mass of the Lord's Supper since the two services have an intimate and necessary link.
- 6. Sacrament of penance: If you cannot make a scheduled time, you may call for an appointment (526-4945).
- 7. The Easter Vigil Mass must start in darkness, not earlier. It will lawfully start at 9:00 p.m. this year.
- 8. Circumstances may cause a change in the schedule. Please check the weekly bulletin.
