FATHER DAVE'S COLUMN

On this last day of the Triduum, may the risen Lord bless you abundantly in every way. May he safeguard you through the rest of the fifty days of Easter.

EASTER: TRIDUUM

The Easter Triduum ends today, in the evening. Easter Sunday has two Masses celebrating the Resurrection of the Lord Jesus. The Vigil counts as the first Mass of Easter. The Mass on Sunday morning counts as the second Mass of Easter.

The arrangement of the titles, texts and pages of the new Missal emphasize the Vigil Mass as an Easter Sunday Mass.

The Easter Triduum celebrates the memory of the death and resurrection of the Lord Jesus. He does not, however, die again and rise again: he did this once for all at the first Easter. The newly baptized have a first experience of the dying and rising of the Lord Jesus in baptism. The already baptized have had another experience of his dying and rising.
