THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD

The Ascension of the Lord marks another stage in the glorification of the Lord Jesus. In the gospel according to John, Jesus ascended into heaven on the day he rose from the dead. He also bestowed the Holy Spirit upon the Church on the day of his resurrection.

Luke, however, puts the ascension forty days after the resurrection. Luke gives us time to assimilate the heavy data of the resurrections. We follow Luke's lead in celebrating the Paschal Mystery of Easter for fifty days.

We ought not to ask which has it right because both John and Luke have it right. Each, however, comes at the mystery of Christ from a different perspective.
