On the seventh, the Archbishop visited us for Confirmation. On May 13, Father Joe Grilliot visited Holy Family from his assignment in California. This week, we have a representative of the Archbishop with us again.

### VIGIL OF PENTECOST: 5:00 MASS NEXT WEEK

The vigil of Easter had us awaiting the Resurrection of the Lord Jesus in the context of baptism. The Vigil of Pentecost has us awaiting the Spirit promised by the Lord. The new Roman Missal has restored to us the Vigil of Pentecost with four readings from the Hebrew Scriptures and the Epistle and Gospel.

The restored vigil will make us of all the scriptural reading for the vigil instead of having us choose only one of them. We shall hear from Genesis 11 the tower of babel, from Exodus 19, God's coming to Moses on Mt Sinai, Ezekiel 37 and the vision of the dry bone and from Joel 3, the outpouring of the Holy Spirit.

I recommend your coming to the vigil. Those conscious of time, I estimate that it will take about ten minutes longer than other Saturday evening Masses.


